Group Rating Program

Group Rating enables small employers with better-than-average claim histories to join together for the purpose of being rated as a larger group. By participating in group rating, employers enjoy a much lower premium than could be attained on their own. Premiums are still payable to the BWC, however, the reduced rate charged by the BWC will be reflected on the payroll report after the group rate is in effect.

As a member, you owe it to your organization to explore all of the savings options available to you.

How Do I Apply?

To request a free, no obligation analysis, follow one of the simple steps below to allow the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation to release your claim history to CompManagement:
